# OBJECTIVE / METHODS / CONTENT



*There is not a lot for our youth to do on this side of town.*

*There is need for youth activity to promote health and wellness, and express diversity, and to have a place kids can explore different sports, arts, interests along with friends and families would help grow a stronger community. I'm doing so can help others in need as well.*

*Excited for a new and local church to be built and hope it is modern and traditional. We need secure and limited places for teens and kids to go on this side of town. Keep God in the building and the people will come. LOVE the idea of a farmers market on this side of town and a food pantry( we run collections in our neighborhood near this location all the time), also having a place where people can meet and do things away from the center of Brownsburg would be great, because a lot of us still feel like outsiders once we pass Northfield Dr.*
