By the numbers...

Measures and Benchmarks as of December 15, 2021

- Number of people in "base": (members and regular participants): 251 (173 adults, 78 children/youth)
- Number of newcomers (people in the pipeline yet to go through Newcomer Initiation): 12 adults
- Rolling attendance last 4 weeks: (113, 88, 114, 113) avg. 107
- Year to date average Sunday attendance: Astrid and I are both up to our eyebrows at this point and Realm won't auto-calculate this now that we have two services a week. We promise to figure out how to get this back in the mix as soon as we clear some breathing space. For real. There has not been breathing space yet but this can absolutely happen in January before BC & annual meeting.
- Year to date average Sunday attendance last year at this time: 132.5
- 2022 amount pledged so far: \$138,446.16
- 2021 amount pledged: 72 pledges for \$162,783
- 2021 amount given: \$128,268.69
- Vicar's community connections: November 2 external, 2 internal, 3 Episcopal. External: planning group for Longest Night (w/clergy from Messiah, Calvary, inclusive Catholics), planning group for Trans Day of Remembrance (w/clergy from Richmond, inclusive Catholics, Roberts UMC downtown Indy)
- Some of you may have seen this week's announcement that the Offices of the Bishop and Cathedral are moving into new space downtown on the circle. Astrid and I were informed ahead (but not allowed to share ahead, sorry) and have been assured that there will continue to be room for us in the new space. Moving out of the old space will take some time, because we want to leave the building but not the ecumenical relationships, so our address won't change until sometime in the new year.
- External/internal/Episcopal balance was definitely tilted toward Stuff That Makes Church Run Like Church and ongoing projects like the Trinity Wall Street connection this month and my attention was much more focused inside Good Sam's than outside it.
